The Bakersfield Condors were repeat winners of the Beautiful Bakersfield Humanitarian Award Presented by the Greater Bakersfield Chamber of Commerce

The Condors made nearly 200 community appearances to various locations including schools, hospitals, non-profit events and the surrounding communities of Bakersfield.

Jersey Off Our Back Auctions raised a cumulative \$100,175 for local organizations.

-IN THE CROWD-

Total season attendance in 2007-08 was 217,698

- The Condors drew 8,895 fans on Nov. 24, the second-largest crowd in team history.
- Condors attendance has increased 34% from 2003-04.
- Drew more than 6,000 fans for 15 of the team's 36 regular season games.

Average per game attendance was 5,628, which was 35% higher than the league average.

- The Condors ranked 5th out of 25 teams in the ECHL for regular season attendance.
- The Condors were 2nd in the league in per game average playoff attendance.
- Voted as one of the "Best in Bakersfield" for Family Attractions in 2007.

The Condors welcomed their 2 millionth fan in their 10 year history on Feb 24, 2008.

- This total is more than all other local college & professional sports team combined during the same time period.
