



An Easy Way to Raise \$200 for the Hockey-Thon

Donate \$10 yourself and ask friends to donate \$10 each

Ask friends to donate \$5 each

Ask your parents and their friends to donate \$20 each

Ask your neighbors to donate to your skating in the Hockey-Thon

Hold a bottle/can drive

Keep a change jar at your parents or parents friends place of business (with permission)

Mow someone's lawn to raise money and charge them a fee; make sure you ask if you can first.

Rake leaves/yard work

Ask your parent/boss to match the total you raise for the hockey-thon

Walk a dog for a fee

Babysit for a donation

Hold a car wash with other hockey-thon participants and divide the donations amongst the workers. Just ask for donations at the car wash, you tend to make more money than asking for a flat dollar amount.

Carry your donation form and envelope everywhere you go. Put your contribution down on the first line. Make sure the first few donations are significant. People tend to follow suit; if you start with a \$3 contribution, the others may do the same.
